Rules and Regulations for Trash & Recycling Programs

CURBSIDE TRASH MUST BE IN CONTAINERS WITH LIDS

Trash may be placed in plastic bags, however, all trash must be placed in metal or plastic trash receptacles with lids at a maximum weight of 50 lbs. per container. Container may not exceed 32 gallons. Containers may not be placed at curbside before 5:00 p.m. on the day before collection day and must be removed by 5:00 p.m. on the day of collection. Trash and recycles must be at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on collection days.

NO ESTABLISHMENT MAY EXCEED 10 RECEPTACLES OR THEIR EQUIVALENT AT ANY ONE COLLECTION

RECYCLABLE INFORMATION

BOTTLES AND CANS (ITEMS CAN BE MIXED IN A RECYCLE CONTAINER, BUT NOT IN PLASTIC BAGS

- Glass bottles and jars (all colors)
- Household plastic container (i.e. detergent, cooking oil & bleach) #1 and #2 only
- Aluminum cans
- Tin plated steel cans (i.e. fruit, vegetable, fish and pet foods)
- Plastic soda and water bottles, milk jugs, detergent, bleach and cooking oil containers #1 and #2 only
- Bi-metal cans (i.e. non-aluminum beverage cans)

Motor Oil and Cooking Oil will be accepted at the Convenience/Recycling Center.

PAPER (ITEMS ARE TO BE BUNDLED OR PLACED IN BROWN PAPER BAGS)
